Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) encompass a broad range of wireless and wire line communications-based information and electronics technologies. When integrated into the transportation system's infrastructure, and in vehicles themselves, these technologies relieve congestion, improve safety, and enhance American productivity.

The goal of the Intelligent Transportation Society of Pennsylvania (ITSPA) is to promote, enhance, educate, and advance the use of technology to create a more economical, efficient and environmentally sound transportation system in Pennsylvania.

The \$1,500.00 ITSPA Annual Scholarship is awarded to the individual in an undergraduate or graduate program who meets the below minimum requirements and demonstrates exemplary aptitude in the areas of civil and/or electrical engineering in the transportation industry.

Requirements

The following are minimum requirements that must be met in order to qualify for the Scholarship:

- Minimum Overall Grade Point Average of 3.0 (An official copy of your most recent transcripts must accompany your application.)
- Completion of the application form including signature certifying accuracy and acceptance of all stated terms and conditions. Include academic transcripts listing courses and GPA.
- Submittal of an original essay defining career goals and educational objectives pertaining to the use of technology in the transportation industry. The essay should be no longer than two (2) pages single-spaced, typewritten, 12-point font, times new roman text with one-inch margins.
- At the discretion of ITSPA, candidates may be requested to meet with Selection Committee for a personal interview.
- Must not receive more than 75% funding from other sources towards the cost of tuition and/or books.
- Applicant must be a US Citizen attending a college or university in Pennsylvania.
- Student must be, or must become a student member of ITSPA prior to the award of the scholarship.
- The Scholarship winner will be announced on or near May 1, 2010 on the ITSPA website at www.itspennsylvania.com.

All applications, essays, and transcripts must be received by Dan Corey, committee chairman, no later than March 31, 2010.

Terms and Conditions

1. The Scholarship is for one year, to be applied to the cost of tuition or textbooks.
2. The student shall provide course schedules, evidence of academic performance, and other information particular to the release of funds prior to the beginning of the school term.
3. Student agrees by acceptance of the Scholarship to allow the ITSPA Board of Directors to consult directly with the College or University regarding the student's performance and to access student records.
4. The recipient must attend a minimum of one (1) ITSPA meeting within six (6) months of receiving this award as determined by ITSPA. ITSPA will pay the registration cost of attendance.
5. In order to qualify for the Scholarship, students must start their next year of study at the beginning of the next full semester following award of the Scholarship. Any student not beginning studies in accordance with this provision shall forfeit their funding and the Scholarship will be null and void.
6. Failure to meet and abide by any of these conditions as outlined above shall result in termination of the Scholarship funding.

- Participation in academic or professional societies.
- Financial need
- Related work experience
- US citizenship and enrollment in a Pennsylvania College or University
- Oral interview (if required)
